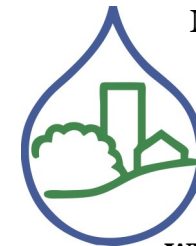

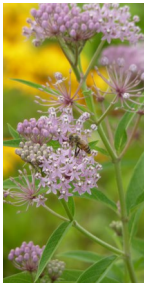

Pond Clinic

Offered to assist current and future pond owners with common challenges and new ideas. Alternated between Preble and Montgomery county locations.

Fall Fest / Annual Mtg.

The Montgomery Soil & Water Conservation District (SWCD) is a political subdivision of the State of Ohio

SWCDs are locally led entities that provide nonregulatory conservation direction. SWCDs have a responsibility to conserve soil, water and related resources by working with landowners at a local level to decrease soil erosion and improve water quality.
